

The Chanukah Question is back!

By popular demand, the Chanukah question is back again this year!

Once again this year during the Chanukah Party, the children of the Kehilla can make some Torah Chanukah Gelt (Yiddish for money).

For each correct answer that the child responds to the famous question of the Bait Yosef, the child will be awarded one dollar!

The question and the rules follow:

The Question: The flask of oil which was found contained oil for one day. Why then do we celebrate 8 days of Chanukah, if there was enough oil for one day; we should theoretically celebrate only 7 days?

The Rules:

- 1) Each child will be allowed only one chance to present their answers.
- 2) The child must present the question and the answers themselves without help from anyone else. Of course, a parent, sibling or friend may accompany them for moral support.
- 3) The child MAY have notes, however the notes must be written in the child's own handwriting
- 4) The child must clearly comprehend and explain the question and answers
- 5) The child must first properly relate the question of the Bait Yosef
- 6) For each correct answer, the child will BE"H be awarded one dollar.
- 6) For any child who can provide 10 answers or more, the child will receive an extra bonus of 3 dollars.
- 7) The Rabbi is the sole judge of what is considered a correct answer or the child's level of understanding.
- 8) Children up to and including 15 year olds may participate.
- 9) The contest is open until the Rabbi runs out of the money he brought.
